"TAKE UP YOUR DAILY CROSS AND FOLLOW ME"

fter prophesying for the first time about His Passion, Jesus spoke, "If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me. For those who want to save their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for my sake will save it. What does it profit them if they gain the whole world, but lose or forfeit themselves?"

(St. Luke 9:23-25)

By these words, Jesus clearly means that each and every soul is precious to the extent that it cannot be bought in exchange for the whole world. The Heavenly Father along with all the angels and saints in Heaven rejoice over a sinner who repents and comes back to Him. (St. Luke 15:7) But have you ever realized the fact that your soul is very much precious and dear to the Father, your Creator? He loves you. He loves each and every person and does not wish the loss of anyone at any cost. He sent his only Son into this sinful world of darkness, so that everyone who believes in Him may



not perish but may have eternal life with Him in heaven. Because Jesus, His beloved son, died on the cross bearing all the pain, rejection and insults for all the sinners, including us, for the sanctification of our souls, for our redemption from our sins. (St. John 3:16; Ephesians 2:4-5)

This was to show for all ages to come that "For by grace you have

been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God—not the result of works, so that no one may boast."

(Ephesians 2:8)

"For there is no distinction, since all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God; they are now justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God put forward as a sacrifice of atonement by his blood, effective through faith. He did this to show his righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over the sins previously committed; it was to prove at the present time that he himself is righteous and that he justifies the one who has faith in Jesus."

(Romans 3:23-26)

What a great and unending love has our Heavenly Father for us? Yet, death could not bind Jesus in chains for long, for He rose again from the dead on the third day.

Hence, "We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again; death no

WHAT DO YOU KNOW ABOUT RESURRECTION?

esurrection is the rising again from the dead, the resumption of life. The Fourth Lateran Council teaches that all men, whether elect or reprobate, "will rise again with their own bodies which they now bear about with them." In the language of the creeds and professions of faith this return to life is called resurrection of the body for

a double reason: first, since the soul cannot die, it cannot be said to return to life; second the heretical contention of Hymeneus (1Tim 1:20) and Philetus that the Scriptures denote by resurrection not the return to life of the body, but the rising of the soul from the death of sin to the life of grace, must be excluded.

In the New Testament, the resurrection

of the dead was expressly taught by Christ (John 5:28-29; 6:39-40; 11:25; Luke 14:14) and defended against the unbelief of the Sadducees, whom He charged with ignorance of the power of God and of the Scriptures (Matt. 22:29; Luke 20:37). St. Paul places the general resurrection on the same level of

"But we do not want you to be uninformed, brothers and sisters, about those who have died, so that you may not grieve as others do who have no hope."

(1 Thess. 4:13)

hristians do not grieve as the world grieves. The world experiences sorrow without hope. The christian also has sorrow, but the Christian's sorrow is accompanied by hope.

In Jesus' day, a funeral was a time for an impassioned demonstration of grief. It was a sign of respect for the deceased to wail loudly ata funeral. A person grieving the loss of a loved one had no power to change what had happened. There was probably no time in human experience when people felt more helpless or vulnerable than at a funeral.

Jesus, too, wept at the funeral of a close friend, but His sorrow did not come from a lack of hope. (John 11:35) Jesus knew that Lazarus, His dear friend, would be alive again. He also

certainty with that of Christ's Resurrection: "If Christ be preached, that he rose again from the dead, how do some among you say that there is no resurrection of the dead? But if there be no resurrection of the dead, then Christ is not risen again. And if Christ be not risen again, then is our preaching vain, and your faith is also vain" (1Cor.15:12 seq.). The Apostle preached the resurrection of the dead as one of the fundamental doctrines of Christianity, at Athens, for instance (Acts 17:18, 31, 32), at Jerusalem (Acts 23:6), before Felix (Acts 24:15), before Agrippa (26:8), He insists on the same doctrine in his Epistles (Rom.8:11; 1Cor.6:14; 15:12 seq.; 2 Cor.4:14; 5:1 seq.; Phil.3:21; 1Thess.4:12-16; 2 Tim.2:11; Hebrews 6:2), and in this he agrees with the Apocalypse (20:12 seq.).

knew that at His second coming. Lazarus and all of Jesus' followers would be resurrected from death to spend eternity with Him in heaven. Jesus wept because He saw the hopelessness felt by the people He loved. His friends had the Resurrection and the Life right in their midst, yet they were grieving!(John 11:25)

When Jesus conquered death, He forever changed the way Christians view death. Christians still experience the sorrow of losing someone we love, but we have hope because we know that God can bring good out of any situation (Rom. 8:28). We have hope in the knowledge that nothing, not even death, can separate us from God's love (Rom. 8:38-39). We have hope because Jesus will bring us to join Him in heaven so that we might enjoy eternity in uninhindered fellowship with Him.

(John 14:3)

Even though you are a Christian, you cannot escape life's sorrows. But you can temper your grief with the hope that Christ is risen and is present with us, For He is your hope and your comfort.

There is a difference between the earthly and the risen body: for the risen bodies of both saints and sinners shall be invested with immortality. This admirable restoration of nature is the result of the glorious triumph of Christ over death as described in several texts of Sacred Scripture.

CHARACTERISTICS OF CHRIST'S RESURRECTION

The Resurrection of Christ has much in common with the resurrection; even the transformation of His body and of His bodily life is of the same kind as that which awaits the blessed in their resurrection. But the following peculiarities must be noted:

-Christ's body was to know no corruption, but rose again soon after death, when sufficient time had elapsed to leave no doubt as to the reality of His death.

-Christ was the first to rise unto life immortal: those raised before Him died again (Col.1:18; 1 Cor.15:20).

-As the Divine power which raised Christ from the grave was His own power. He rose from the dead by His own power (John 2:19; 10:17-18).

-Since the Resurrection had been promised as the main proof of Christ's Divine mission, it has a greater dogmatic importance than any other fact. "If Christ be not risen again, then is our preaching vain, and your faith is also vain."(1Cor. 15:14).

IMPORTANCE OF THE RESURRECTION

Besides being the fundamental argument for our Christian belief, the Resurrection is important for the following reasons:

-It shows the justice of God who exalted Christ to a life of glory, as Christ had humbled Himself unto death (Phil. 2:8-9).

-The Resurrection completed the mystery of our salvation and redemption; by His death Christ freed us from sin, and by His Resurrection He restored to us the most important privileges lost by sin (Rom. 4:25).

-By His Resurrection we acknowledge Christ as the immortal God, the efficient and exemplary cause of our own resurrection (1Cor. 15:21; Phil. 3: 20-21), and as the model and the support of our new life of grace (Rom. 6:4-6; 9-11).

longer has dominion over him. The death he died, he died to sin, once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God. So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus."(Romans 6:9-11)

St. Peter writes in his letter, "For to this you have been called, because Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example, so that you should follow in his steps."

(1Peter 2:21)




