make his paths straight. Every valley shall be filled, and every mountain and hill shall be made low, and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough ways made



smooth: and all flesh shall see the salvation of God.' (Luke 3:4-6) If we are to receive the powerful presence of God, we must prepare ourselves. John the Baptist was God's messenger, called as the forerunner of Jesus, to help people prepare to receive the Saviour of the world. John preached unwaveringly: "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!" (Matt.3:2) Those who heard John's message and prepared their lives recognized Jesus when He came, and they left all to follow Him. This was especially true of the disciples, whose hearts God himself prepared (Matt. 6:17) God's instruction for preparation is specific: repentance! This involves a complete change of mind, heart, will, and behaviour toward Him. He is Lord, and your life must be prepared to receive Him as your Lord. Anything less is inadequate. JESUS CHRIST, OUR LORD & KING THE FULFILLER OF ALL PROPHECIES

or the Gospel writers, one of the main reasons for believing in Jesus was the way his life fulfilled the Old Testament prophecies about the promised Messiah. The Gospel of Matthew, written especially for the Jews to convince them that Jesus is the prophesied Messiah and the Eternal King promised by God through the prophets, relies heavily on the Old Testament passages concerning the Saviour starting from Jesus' birth to his teachings and to his crucifixion (Mt. 1:21-23; 2:14-15; 2:16-18; 2:23; 13:34-35; 21:3-5; 27:9; 27:35). One phrase runs through this Gospel like an ever-recurring theme - "This was to fulfill what had been spoken by


the Lord through the prophet." This phrase occurs in the Gospel about 16 times. It is thus Matthew's primary and deliberate purpose to show how every detail of Jesus' life was foretold by the prophets; and thus to compel the Jews to admit that Jesus was the Messiah. In the other Gospels too, we find many more prophecies being quoted by the evangelists, which are fulfilled in Jesus and thus convincing the readers that it was all under the Divine plan of God to redeem and sanctify His people through the precious Blood shed by His Son on the Cross for all mankind. The following list of prophecies (given in the table) find their fulfillment in Jesus of Nazareth, the promised Messiah, in the New Testament -

XX. THE DIVINE SIDE OF JESUS Fear and Astonishment

Mark never forgot the divine side of Jesus. He begins his Gospel with the declaration of faith, "The beginning of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God." He leaves us in no doubt what he believed Jesus to be. Again and again he speaks of the impact Jesus made on the mind and heart of those who heard him. The awe astonishment which he evoked. (due to his authoritative teaching or his words and deeds, that is, performing miracles or healings) lare always before Mark's mind. "They were astounded at his teaching." (Mk. 1:22) "They were all amazed." (1:27) Such phrases occur again and again. Not only was this astonishment in the minds of the crowds who listened to Jesus; it was still more in the minds of the inner circle of the disciples, "And they were filled with awe, and said to one another, "Who then is this, that even wind and sea obey him?"" (4:41) Besides overcoming with astonishment, there are few instances where the disciples were afraid (feared) or terrified. "...and Jesus was walking ahead of them; they were amazed, and those who followed were afraid." (10:32) To Mark, Jesus was not simply a man among men; He was God among men, ever moving them to a wonderful amazement with his

words and deeds.



Praise be to Jesus! Thanks be to Jesus! My daughter Pooja aged 4years lost her eyesight totally last month. At first her eyes started turning reddish and later gradually she lost her vision. I showed her to some ENT specialists in Faridabad but everywhere I got the same answer: "We do not have any treatment for her eyes and cannot help her get back her eyesight. She will not be able to see anymore in future". Then I took her to the Apollo Hospital where the opthalmologist, after examining her eyes, suggested an operation. He told me that replacing her eyes with someone else's would be the only solution possible and it involved an expenditure over one-and-a-half lakh rupees. I had already spent by this time over Rs. 30,000 on her treatment and I was not in a position to meet such a huge expense with my meager income. However, the doctor fixed a date in the first week of November for her operation and notified me to deposit the amount by October last.

It was at this this juncture that God came to my rescue through one of my friends who advised me to go to Jeevan Dham and attend the prayer service on Sunday. He brought me to this place and I listened to the Word of God and the testimonies given by those who received favours. I got the oil and water blessed from here and prayed to God to help my daughter who always kept her eyes closed. She was unable to eat or even get up from her bed and walk.
