celebration like any other Friday. This Friday was special as the Auxiliary Bishop of Delhi Archdiocese, Rev. Anil Couto was the main celebrant. His Lordship was welcomed with a garland. The concelebrants were Rev. Fr. Albert Francis, Rev.Fr. Anthony Francis, Rev. Fr. Thomas Chambakatt, Rev. Fr. Jose Pulickakunnel (SSP) and Rev. Fr. John Katuparambil (CMI). On this occasion His Lordship delivered a meaningful and thought-provoking homily based on the day's readings and the Gospel. At the Communion rite, a memorable vision caught me unawares, throwing me into ecstasy. I saw two beams of red light streaming down from heaven over the Host and the chalice held by the Bishop. He too was enveloped by this light and gradually the whole room was filled with it. Besides, I saw esus himself holding the Host in Mace of the Bishop and several langels dancing and praising around the altar. The host had red blood droplets on its surface. Later, I saw our Lord blessing the Bishop and the concelebrants.

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July 3. Thomas did not idolize his doubts; he gladly believed when given reasons to do so. He expressed his doubts fully and had them answered completely. Doubting was only his way of responding, not his way of life.

Although our glimpses of Thomas are brief, his character comes through with consistency. He struggled to be faithful to what he knew, despite what he felt. At one point, when it was plain to everyone that Jesus' life was

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DIVINE VISION CAUGHT IN A CAMERA!

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After the Mass, I narrated this vision to all present there. So many of them experienced peace and heavenly blessings and healings that special Friday morning. When I asked whether anyone had seen anything in vision as I had seen, few raised their hands. Three of them saw the red light filling the room. One saw the host turning red with blood and the angels praising around the altar. Another saw a dove (sign of the Holy Spirit) hovering around the room and above the altar. The coherence of all these visions was clearly a sign of the presence of the one Holy Spirit that revealed the truth of such visions to different persons.

But God had blessed this day and made it very special with a miracle never heard or seen before. One of the photographers, standing on the left side of the altar had taken a closeup shot with his digital camera at the moment when His Lordship was lifting the host and the chalice for all to see, (the same moment when I had seen the red light beaming down from heaven) declaring that "this was **the Lamb of God, who shed His**

in danger, only Thomas put into words what most were feeling, "Let's go, too-and die with Jesus." (John 11:16). He didn't hesitate to follow Jesus.

We dont' know why Thomas was absent the first time Jesus appeared to His disciples after the Resurrection, but he was reluctant to believe their witness to Christ's resurrection. Not even 10 friends could change his mind! But Jesus wasn't hard on Thomas for his doubts. Despite his skepticism, Thomas was still loyal to the believers and to Jesus himself.

We can doubt without having to live a doubting way of life. Doubt encourages rethinking. Its purpose is more to sharpen the mind than to change it. Doubt can be used to pose the question, get an answer, and blood and sacrificed His life, who takes away the sins of the world." The miracle is that this snap has the same aura of the red light that enveloped the surroundings and the host. All the other snaps taken by him have the normal appearance, except this one, which made him eager and curious. What an unbelievable miracle! All those who had never had any visions could see now this vision with open eyes in this exceptional snap taken by a digital camera.

It was truly through the Holy Spirit that Jesus wanted to reveal to everyone with this miracle the sanctity and truth of His Body and Blood being offered in every Holy Mass, the real food and the real drink (John 6:55) that came from Heaven for our souls (John 6:51), offered in His true love for our sanctification, salvation and Eternal life in Heaven (John 6:53-54).

I recall the promise given by Jesus to us about the gift of the Holy Spirit from heaven to all who pray to Him, love Him and believe in His holy name. Jesus has promised, "If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, to be with you forever. This is the Spirit of

push for a decision. But doubt was never meant to be a permanent condition. Doubt is one foot lifted, poised to step forward or backward. There is no motion until the foot comes down.

When you experience doubt, take encouragement from Thomas. He didn't stay in his doubt but allowed Jesus to bring him to belief. Take encouragement also from the fact that countless other followers of Christ have struggled with doubts. The answers God gave them may help you, too. Don't settle into doubts, but move on from them to decision and belief. Find another believer with whom you can share your doubts. silent doubts rarely find answers.

Let us pray to Jesus with a humble and contrite heart and ask Him for the Heavenly gift of the Holy Spirit, which He has promised, so that He may guide us always and lead us to the truth. Let us also ask earnestly for the gift of vision to understand the truth, love and mystery behind the Body and Blood of Christ, mystery behind all the Sacraments, to obtain guidance and wisdom.
