he feast of the Holy Rosary was established by Saint Pius V on the anniversary of the naval victory won by the Christian fleet at Lepanto, October 7, 1571. The victory was attributed to the help of the holy Mother of God whose aid was

invoked through praying the Rosary.

The celebration of this day invites all to mediate upon the mysteries of Christ, following the example of the Blessed Virgin Mary who was so singularly associated with the incarnation, passion and glorious resurrection of the Son of God.On 0September 30, 2001, after the morning Mass opening the Synod of Bishops, Pope John Paul II asked people to pray the Rosary. Here is his message:

"October is the month in which Mary Most Holy, Queen of the Holy Rosary, is venerated. Within the current international context, I invite all --individuals, families, communities -- to pray this Marian prayer, possibly every day, for peace, so that the world can be preserved from the wicked scourge of terrorism." So, let us all pray to the Queen of the Holy Rosary, the Queen of Peace for a peaceful and loving world.

PERSONALITY PROFILE:

LUKE THE EVANGELIST

ne of the essential qualities of a good doctor is compassion. People need to know that their doctor cares. Even if he or she doesn't know what is wrong or isn't sure what to do, real concern is always a doctor's good medicine. Doctor Luke was a person of compassion.

In his Gospel, he emphasizes Jesus Christ's compassion. He vividly recorded both the power demonstrated by Christ's life and the care with which Christ treated people. Luke highlighted the relationships Jesus had with women.

Luke as a doctor had a travelling medical practice as Paul's companion. Paul deeply appreciated Luke's skills and faithfulness. God also made special use of Luke as the historian of the early church. Repeatedly, the details of Luke's descriptions have

am from Calcutta. My name is Victoria. I went to Delhi to attend the R.I. Presidential Polio Summit 2004 held at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi on 7th and 8th August 2004. There were the Honourable President of India and representatives from 14 other countries. There was also Ms.Aishwarya Rai present.

I was staying with the sisters of Auxiliun Convent at Vasant Vihar. There I came to know about your ministry and decided to visit your home and pray for my son, Patrick aged 28, who got a job in United States of America, after trying for 1 and half years. He is in love with a divorced girl aged 35 years and has a 4-years old daughter. I had at first agreed to this marriage saying that we will ask for the annulment by the Church and get them married. So I got them engaged in the month of May 2004. But when I came to know that the girl is not able to give birth to a child any more, and is also very possessive of my son and would not allow him to spend time with me, I disagreed. I told my son that he should not get married to her. On my return to India after visiting him I was in a very bad state of mind. I was always bad tempered, especially with my husband, whom I never loved, but had lived with him for nearly 28 years only for the sake of my two sons and my two sisters and a brother.

On 11th August 2004 I came to your house after the Polio Summit in Delhi. Your house is indeed blessed by the Power of the Almighty God for I felt the presence of Jesus while praying there. I came there by chance, even though I knew (after the telephone call with Mani Didi on the 10th afternoon) that all of you would

I decided to come there to see at least the house so that the next day I would not waste time looking for the place, and could be on time to pray. I am so happy and fortunate to have visited the place where Jesus has shown and is showing His mercy to so many millions of people. I must say it is a sacred place. I thank and Praise the Lord Jesus for your family.

I was amazed to find your house open on the 11th August, even though none of you were at home, and a group of ladies praying very fervently the Rosary, singing Praises and reading the Scripture. I joined them with tears rolling down with gratitude to God for that day's grace of being able to pray in that holy place in front of the tabernacle. I was sure I would find a lock, but still I made effort to visit the place, and the Lord in His mercy has rewarded my effort and allowed me to be with him there in that holy place to speak to Him and Praise him.

The next day I arrived at 9 a.m., I must have been one of the first one to be there. Soon, you came to speak to me, your parents joined in at 9.30 a.m. or so and the Blessed Sacrament was

exposed. Praises, Hymns, Rosary, Adoration and Scripture Reading followed with much devotion. I was spellbound by faith and devotion. Even after the prayer service when most of the people left I stayed on to pray with the different groups that continued the Adoration. At 3.30 p.m once again the blessed couple arrived and started the Chaplet and concluded with a passage from the Scripture. I felt that the particular Reading from the Scripture was all for me (It was about husband and wife's unity and unconditional love and faithfulness which God wants and that no one should go with a divorced person.) It was just too beautiful; I felt Jesus was directly speaking to me and to crown it all Mani Didi pointed out to me saying, "at this moment Jesus is blessing you and your family".

I also felt like praying for a better relationship between my husband and me. I also prayed for my younger son (working in Luxembourg) who desires to get a job in America and was undergoing some interviews.

REFLECTION Of the **WORD**Putting Your Brother First

"Do not seek your own advantage, but that of the other." (1 Corinthians 10:24)

As a Christian you are obliged to view your actions in light of how they will affect other Christians. You will discover God's will for your life when you consider His activity in the lives of others. This goes contrary to worldly thinking. The world encourages you to live your own life, taking care of your own needs and wants first. Sin promotes independence. It isolates you from others and separates you from those you could help or who could encourage you. God designed you for interdependence.

Whenever you meet another Christian, you come face to face with Christ (John 13:20). There ought to be a deep respect within you as you encounter other lives guided by the Holy Spirit. Do not live as if you have no responsibility toward your Christian brothers or sisters. God holds you accountable for how you relate to them. Don't revel in your "freedom in Christ" to the point that you neglect your responsibility toward others (Romans 14:15). Paul celebrated his freedom in Christ, but he was keenly sensitive to what might cause other Christians harm (1Cor. 8:13). He was aware that his sin could not take place in isolation but could bring pain to many others (1 Cor. 5:6). You have a responsibility to live in such a way that you do not hurt others. You must deny yourself and allow the Holy Spirit to put to death your natural inclination to be self-centred. Ask God to free you from selfishness so that your life is free to bless others.
