he word Angel, taken from Latin angelus, a transcription of Greek angelos means "messenger" and in modern Christian belief, known as a heavenly spirit. The most primitive form of Old Testament belief (starting in the book of Genesis from Abraham) in angels seems to be the "messenger of Yahweh". The Scriptures reveal that God created nine orders of Angels out of which the Archangels (seven in all including Michael, Raphael and Gabriel) belong to the eighth order. Book of Revelation are considered to be the Archangels. The Archangels were the Divine Messengers between the humans and God; they are the Battlers of the Sons of Darkness. The Church celebrates the principal Feast of the Archangels on September 29 especially honouring St. Michael the Archangel. It is probably on this date on which the ancient Roman Basilica to 'St.Michael and All Angels' was dedicated in the 6th century, but that building disappeared over a thousand vears ago.

St. Michael (in Hebrew means 'Who is like God') is one of the principal angels; his name was the war-cry of the good angels in the battle fought in heaven against Satan and his followers. Four times his name is recorded in Scripture:(1) Daniel 10:13, (2) in Daniel 12, (3) In the letter of St.Jude 9, and in (4) Revelation12:7. Following these Scriptural passages, Christian tradition gives to St. Michael four offices: a) To fight against Satan, b) To rescue the souls of the faithful from his grasp, especially at the hour of death, c) To be the champion of God's people, and as the Patron of the

Contd... from Page ① Col. ② Church, and d) To call away from earth and bring men's souls to judgment. St.Michael is the Patron Saint of grocers, the guardian of all mountain places, also held to be the special Guardian Angel of the Pope and of the Blessed Sacrament.

Raphael's Hebrew name signifies **'God has healed'.** In the Old Testament it is recorded hoe he cured the blindness of Tobit and acted as a guide during his son's trip to Meria. He is in consequence revered as the Patron Saint of travellers, of the young and the innocent.

Gabriel, meaning '**The Power of God**' in Hebrew, is also one of the Archangels, who in a particular way seems to be the messenger of glad or consoling tidings. He is known as 'the Angel of the Annunciation' for having been sent to inform Our Lady that she had been chosen to become the Mother of the Incarnate Word, He gave the message to the shepherds at Bethlehem and to St.Joseph in connection with the flight of the Holy Family to Egypt.

REFLECTION OF the WORD <u>An IMPERISHABLE ©ROWN</u>

"Do you not know that in a race the runners all compete, but only one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may win it. Athletes exercise self-control in all things; they do it to receive a perishable wreath, but we an imperishable one."

(1 Corinthians 9:24-25)

Athletes are willing to push themselves harder and longer and farther than anyone else. They strive to bring their bodies and minds completely under control so that they excel and receive a prize. Others go home to relax, but athletes continue to train. While most people protect themselves from any form of discomfort, athletes push themselves to the limits of their endurance. While some remain satisfied with their mediocre performance, athletes pay any price for excellence. St. Paul said that despite their most valiant efforts, the athletes' successes and prizes are eventually forgotten. Even the greatest athletic achievements, have not affected eternity.

Are you disciplining your life in prayer? When others are sleeping, are you interceding? Have you studied God's Word so diligently that you are prepared to find answers to the challenges you face? Have you equipped yourself in evangelism so that you are ready to share your faith? Have you prepared yourself as a Christian in order to qualify for the imperishable crown that awaits you? Ask for yourself and find out what answers do you get from your conscience.

Contd... from Page ① Col. ② beginning, God made him a record keeper. Jesus' call eventually allowed him to put his skills to their finest work. Matthew was a keen observer, and he undoubtedly recorded what he saw going on around him. The Gospel that bears his name came as a result.

Matthew's experience points out that each of us, from the beginning, is one of God's works in progress. Much of what God has for us He gives long before we are able to consciously respond to Him. He trusts us with skills and abilities ahead of schedule. He has made each of us capable of being His servant. When we trust Him with what He has given us, we begin a life of real adventure. Matthew could not have known that God would use the very skills he had sharpened as a tax collector to record the greatest story ever lived. And God has no less meaningful purpose for each one of us. Have you recognized Jesus saying to you, "Follow me"? What has been your response?





MY GOD IS MY STRONGHOLD! AN AMAZING WITNESS

Praise be to Jesus! Thanks be to Jesus! I, Gurudutt (age – 40 years),

was physically very weak ever since the age of four. Even a shrill noise was enough to make me fall down unconscious. I could not bear any noise: somebody yelling, or several persons talking together, or a noise from the loudspeakers or TV or vehicles. I could not go near any noisy place. My parents used to admit me in the hospital very often whenever I became unconscious. Yet, the doctors were never able to diagnose the cause behind this weakness. One doctor said that my Blood Pressure level was very low and so I should be given saline water for raising my Blood pressure level to normal. A doctor at Pant Hospital after examining me declared that I'm fine and healthy and need not to worry. But his statement was wrong. Another doctor prescribed 3 tablets (*Ambulax*) a day to be taken all my life. Thereafter, I used to carry these tablets along with me everywhere, since I was afraid I would fall unconscious anywhere anytime. never used to attend marriages or go to any public meetings. I could not travel in a bus.


